452 CE - EXERCISE IN MISAWA

In today's age, where information is accessible in a matter of seconds anywhere in the world, the Pacific Air Force (PACAF) is showing the world their focus on Agile Combat Employment (ACE) and all the Multi-Capable Airman (MCA) training taking place across the Pacific. The first week of March, 5th Air Force and the men and women assigned to the 35th Fighter Wing "Wild Weasels" at Misawa Air Base, Japan showcased their commitment to train by conducting their first bilateral MCA training exercise, alongside the Japan Air Self-Defense Force (JASDF). This exercise had an emphasis on readiness and adaptability working alongside our JASDF counterparts.

The Wild Weasels were not done in the month of March. Two weeks later, Misawa AB conducted Beverly Sunrise Readiness Exercise 24-04, a multifaceted exercise, which included simulated CBRN attacks, Rapid Airfield Damage Recovery, ground defense of the airfield, and also included Non-Combatant Evacuation operations. This exercise was not with the JASDF, instead it showcased a total force approach. Three separate Air Force Reserve units took part in this exercise, with units from Davis Monthan Air Force Base, Homestead AFB, and our very own March ARB.

Members from the 452d Civil Engineer Squadron (CES), Emergency Management (EM) Team served in various key roles for this exercise. They led the inspection team in the 24-hour CBRN center and the Emergency Operations Center. The 452d CES EM team also showcased their knowledge and expertise leading multiple Post-Attack Reconnaissance (PAR) teams through the various Mission-Oriented Protective Posture Analysis (MOPP) levels. The PAR teams conducted operations in full CBRN-defense individual Protective Equipment for numerous hours throughout the day and night.

At the conclusion of the exercise, Team March demonstrated their skill proficiency, forged valuable connections with Reserve and Active Duty personnel, and received invitations to participate in next year's Beverly Sunrise Readiness Exercise. They confidently showcased the CES motto of FORGING EXCELLENCE.





INCLUDING CHILDREN. ARE MORE THAN WELCOME TO ATTEND!


