SUBJECT: March ARB Environmental Commitment Statement

1. Per Air Force Instruction (AFI) 32-7001, Environmental Management, installations are required to maintain an environmental commitment statement which supports Department of Defense (DoDI) 4715.17 and Air Force Policy Directive (AFPD) 90-8.
2.  - b. Complying with all environmental legal obligations and applicable regulations at the federal as well as California state and local levels; and, conforming to the elements of the ISO 14001 EMS standard.
 - c. Utilizing our EMS to identify environmental aspects, establish objectives and targets to preserve our natural and cultural assets, reduce environmental risk and monitor the installation's environmental health.
 - d. Providing required environmental awareness training for base personnel through the 452d Civil Engineer, Environmental Flight.
